Sister Joanne Callahan, O.S.U., the Bishop's Secretary for Education in the Diocese of Rockville Centre, has asked us to release the following announcement on her behalf:

"After forty-seven years in the field of Catholic education, and after thirty-one years serving the Diocese of Rockville Centre, I have decided to retire on December 31, 2019. I intend to continue to work with my sisters and serve my community as Province Leader for the Ursuline Sisters of Tildonk. I am grateful to God for the many blessings He has given me in my vocation and in my work in Catholic education, and I am especially grateful to the many wonderful people, religious and lay, who have accompanied me in this important mission over the years."
